Spur Afrika

We started our 1st quarter well, but like most organizations around the globe, we were interrupted by the outbreak of COVID 19. Kenya reported her first case on 15th of March and now we have above 1000 confirmed cases.

As an organization we had to put on hold most of our activities and programs, especially events that involve interactions to keep safe and stop the spread (this is per the government directive).



Child Sponsorship

Students, a very essential part of Spur Afrika, are currently at home following a government directive as a way to fight Corona Virus. They remain at home for the moment until further notice because cases keep rising everyday.

However, we are offering alternative learning with tutors for both primary and secondary students.

The first two weeks of March went very well; we went to visit our students in their various schools to encourage them and also find out whether they needed anything or someone to talk to. This is our tradition to make sure that our students are not suffering in silence which is aimed to foster mental, physical, social and most importantly, spiritual growth.



Emergency Food Bank

The child sponsorship program is also concerned with the welfare of the families in which the students come from.

In this hard moment, we extended our care to the families under the sponsorship program by creating a temporary emergency food bank with the following food items:

1. Maize flour
2. Rice
3. Wheat flour
4. Sugar
5. Beans
6. Green grams
7. Soap
8. Sanitary packs
9. Salt

Spur Afrika created the above food bank after realizing that most parents/care givers lost their jobs due to COVID 19. So far, we have managed to give out food benefiting 100 families (of an average of 6 people) under the sponsorship program for a period of three months i.e. Two weeks in March, April, May and June.




Mentorship
